Unit 2: Make Hummus

- 1 can chickpeas (15.5 ounces)
- 2 tablespoons tahini
- 1 clove garlic
- 3 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ¼ cup very cold water
- olive oil
- paprika
- pita bread or veggie sticks (such as bell peppers and carrots) for dipping

Unit 3: Make Pet Passports

- 2 pieces of white paper
- 1 piece of card stock or construction paper
- ruler
- scissors
- stapler
- pencil or pen
- picture of pet (printed or drawn), 2" x 2"

Unit 4: Design Unique Buildings

Choose either:

- paper and pencils, markers, crayons, etc.
- toy building blocks

Unit 5: Make Edible Pyramid Scenes

- kiwi
- cereal squares
- animal crackers
- pretzel dipping sticks
- plates (1 per person)
- knife

Unit 6: Make a Royal Court

- air-dry clay (we used a terra-cotta color)
- red, black, and white paint (acrylic or washable kids paint)
- ruler
- plastic knife
- paintbrushes
- string

Unit 7: Make a Bible Recording

- Bible
- electronic device capable of recording audio

Unit 8: Make Malva Pudding

- 1 cup flour
- 1 tablespoon baking soda
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 3 tablespoons apricot jam
- 1 tablespoon vinegar
- 1 tablespoon melted butter, cooled to room temperature
- 1 cup milk

Unit 9: Make Cork Coasters

- package of cork coasters
- craft paint in the colors of your choice
- Mod Podge (look for a container that says "Dishwasher Safe")
- paintbrushes

Unit 10: Make Paper Volcanoes

- baking soda
- vinegar
- yellow, red, and orange craft paint
- blue and black cardstock
- glue stick
- paintbrushes
- scissors
- wooden skewers to mix paint
- 3 small disposable containers to mix paint and baking soda together
- spray bottle for vinegar

Unit 11: Make Tartines With Chocolate

- loaf of dense bread
- bar of dark chocolate
- softened butter

If you want to make your own bread, here are the ingredients for a no-knead bread recipe made with a Dutch oven.

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1½ teaspoons salt
- 1/2 teaspoon instant yeast
- 1½ cups warm water

Unit 12: Stuffed Animal Patrol

- 10 stuffed animals
- stopwatch
- paper and pencil

Unit 13: Make Wooden Crosses

- twigs or large craft sticks
- twine
- acrylic paint or kids washable craft paint (optional)
- paintbrushes (optional)
- scissors

Unit 14: Make Polish Gingerbread

Gingerbread:

- 6 ounces honey
- 5 tablespoons butter
- ½ cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons water
- 1½ teaspoons gingerbread spice (We used the gingerbread spice recipe below. You can substitute pumpkin pie spice or cinnamon, though this will alter the flavor.)
- 1 medium egg, beaten
- 4½ cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 3 tablespoons sour cream

Gingerbread Spice:

- 1½ teaspoons ground cinnamon
- ½ teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1½ teaspoons ground ginger
- ½ teaspoon ground black pepper
- ½ teaspoon ground allspice
- pinch ground clove (less than ½ teaspoon)

Chocolate Glaze:

- 1½ cups powdered sugar
- ½ cup cocoa powder
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3-4 tablespoons milk

Unit 15: Paint Matryoshka Dolls

- set of blank wooden nesting dolls (available from online retailers)
- pencil
- acrylic craft paint in the colors of your choice
- child-safe varnish (optional)
- paintbrushes

Unit 16: Play Pillowcase Buzkashi

- pillowcase
- flag of some type (a rag will do fine)
- ribbon or string

Unit 17: Make Coconut Ladoo

- 1½ cups + ¼ cup unsweetened coconut (fresh, frozen, or desiccated)
- ½ cup + 2 tablespoons sweetened condensed milk
- ¼ teaspoon cardamom (or 1 teaspoon vanilla extract)

Unit 18: Make Hangul Sachets

 one 9" x 12" piece of classic felt (One piece will make 2 sachets. You can use any color, but a lighter color will be much easier for tracing the design.)

- lavender buds (You can find these online or at craft stores. Check the aisle with candle making supplies.)
- embroidery floss (any color)
- sewing thread (the same color as the felt)
- embroidery needle
- ruler
- scissors
- pencil

Unit 19: Make Felt Pandas

- white felt
- black felt
- white thread
- needle
- cotton balls
- ribbon, yarn, or string for a hanger
- googly eyes
- black marker
- scissors
- glue
- pins
- round object to trace panda head shape (such as a mug)
- smaller round object to trace panda ears (such as a spice jar lid)

Unit 20: Eat a Floating Village

- 6 ounce box of blue JELL-O
- 1 envelope of unflavored gelatin
- 2½ cups of water
- · chocolate candy wafers
- pretzel dipping sticks
- graham crackers
- mini marshmallows

Unit 21: Paint Australian Sunsets

- paints of your choice
- artist paper or canvas
- paintbrushes
- glue
- printout of the Kangaroo Silhouette template (available at notgrass.com/ ogbwlinks)

Unit 22: Make JESUS Posters

- artist paper or posterboard
- markers

Unit 23: Make Apple Pie

- 2 tablespoons freshly squeezed lemon juice (from 1 lemon)
- 3 pounds baking apples
- 2/3 cup sugar, plus more for sprinkling on top
- ¼ cup unsalted butter
- ¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ¼ teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1 egg, lightly beaten
- 2 pie crusts (we used refrigerated pie crust)

Unit 24: Play Polar Bear Race

- game board, game cards, and game pieces (available at notgrass.com/ ogbwlinks)
- 3 pieces of white cardstock
- scissors
- 1 game die

Unit 25: Make Monarch Suncatchers

- wax paper
- pencil
- partial bottle of liquid school glue
- black and orange craft paint
- paintbrush

Unit 26: Make Guatemalan Atolillo

- ¼ cup long grain white rice
- 1 cup water
- 3½ cups milk
- 2½ tablespoons sugar
- 1 cinnamon stick or ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon

Unit 27: Start a Family Band!

- wooden, plastic, and metal objects
- recording of steel pan music (visit notgrass.com/ogbwlinks)

- dirt
- flower seeds
